Admission requirements	Undergraduate B.A., B.F.A., or B.S. degree in any major. Admission process	The admission process is competitive and requires an online application. Selected candidates are interviewed, with a normal acceptance of 10 students per cohort.

Student support	We guarantee internship support for the semester internship placements required over two years. Summer internship positions are not guaranteed support. In addition, students apply for scholarships upon entry, with merit based opportunities after admission.
Additional sources of income and support	Travel costs and related expenses are reimbursed for the annual AMIA conference. Opportunities for work at NYU include as a DPOE-N fellow, various graduate assistantships, graduate assistant in various areas, as well as positions in the preservation department of the University library.
Duration of study	Two years of study.
